SUBJECT: Presidential Interview with Spanish Today

Richard Darman has asked that comments on the attached written interview with the President be sent directly to Mike Baroody by close of business today. The questions and answers focus on issues of particular concern to the Hispanic community, including minority businesses, immigration legislation, education, and narcotics trafficking. The draft answer to the question concerning our position on illegal immigrants living in the United States omits any reference to the legalization aspect of Simpson - Mazolli. I think this audience would be pleased that we are trying to grant legal status to their illegal amigos. This point, and two minor stylistic ones, are made in the attached draft memorandum to Baroody.
