### RESOLUTION TO IMPROVE TRANSPORTATION IN TEXAS

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Texas LULAC State Convention go on record as urging Amtrak to establish a southern triangle linking the cities of Laredo, San Antonio, and Brownsville, and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED that Amtrak includes Texas LULAC in the planning and development process to insure our citizens are adequately and fairly served in a timely manner.
